Prom Dress Code - *Formal Attire is Expected*

Females:

- Strapless dresses, dresses with spaghetti straps, or halter top dresses that meet the guidelines below are acceptable to wear.
- Dresses should be modestly cut - no plunging neckline.
- No two-piece, bra-top-type dresses.
- All dresses must modestly cover the mid-riff region and be modest in style with NO sheer fabric.
- No see through tops or bra-tops
- No “mesh” that attaches a bra top to a skirt bottom, thus making it a one-piece dress (example #3)
- No visible undergarments
- No slits higher than fingertip length.
- These are examples of dresses that would **NOT BE ALLOWED**:



Males:

- Formal attire is expected.
- Dress suit and tie, jacket and tie or tuxedo, dress pants (no shorts, worn jeans, polo shirts)
- No non-formal headwear allowed: baseball caps, do rags, etc.

As this is a school-sponsored activity, ANY PERSON that attends the Henrietta High School events MUST be in compliance with the dress code and all Henrietta High School Policies & Procedures.

Questionable attire will be left to the discretion of the Administrators on duty.

Any person who is out of dress code compliance will **NOT** receive a refund.
